The program is a paid, full-time internship, with flexible start and end dates and is based in the San Francisco or the Seattle office. In-person, attendance will be required for the duration of the internship, pending no changes to COVID-related protocols for on-site attendance, in which case we would switch to hybrid or fully remote work. Interns should be year 3 or higher in an undergraduate architecture program or have completed 1 year of a graduate program. Recently graduated students will not be considered for an internship, but applicants will be considered for current or full-time positions as available.

EHDD is committed to providing interns a meaningful variety of experiences that provide exposure to the many different aspects of the profession. As a teaching office, EHDD offers many fantastic resources, both in its library and its network. Interns work as an active member of a project team and are encouraged to attend meetings and site visits. They will participate in the iterative process as we synthesize site context, sustainability, program, stakeholder feedback, and other criteria into a timeless design. Interns are also asked to give a presentation to the office on a topic of interest.
